### Riverfront Improvement Commission Minutes March 23, 2021

Chairman Bruemmer called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and welcomed all in attendance. Ahrens announced that a quorum for the meeting had been met, and instructions were provided regarding tonight's meeting protocol.

Ashton moved to approve the minutes of the February 23, 2021 meeting. Churchill seconded the motion and carried unanimously.

#### Finance

Ahrens presented and provided updates regarding the month's disbursements, aged receivables report and the FY2021 Lease Report. Grubbs moved to approve the disbursements. Lee seconded the motion and it carried.

### **Projects**

Bruemmer introduced Brian Ritter, Executive Director of Nahant Marsh, who provided the Commission with a presentation. Following the presentation, there was discussion, including Nahant's request for a Support Letter from the Commission for its upcoming State CAT Grant Application and its request for an addendum to the existing access agreement with adjacent Commission / City-owned land. Staff will follow-up regarding both matters.

Ahrens presented an update regarding Riverfront Refresh 2021. Enhancements include both operations and maintenance as well as programmatic. Working with various interested community stakeholders, there will be a number of special events and activities taking place throughout the riverfront in 2021. In April, the City Council and Riverfront Improvement Commission will co-host Riverfront Refresh Day on Saturday, April 17 at 8am at the Freight House and an exciting new special festival, QC MacDown, will take place on April 24.

### Staff Report

Chair Bruemmer provided a report for the Commission, including the finalization of the annual performance evaluation for staff, which has been shared with Ahrens, Community and Economic Development Director, Bruce Berger, and placed in his personnel file.

Trees provided the Parks and Recreation Report, which included repair of the Credit Island Causeway this Spring and the announcement of several available seasonal job openings within Parks and Recreation.

## Other Business

Bill Handel, citizen, provided comments regarding the riverfront and River Drive. With no additional public with business to present to the Commission, and with no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:20 p.m.

This addendum agreement is made as of May 12, 2021 by and between the City of Davenport through its Riverfront Improvement Commission (hereinafter referred to as "Lessor") and the Nahant Marsh Education Center (the "Nahant Center"), an Iowa not-for-profit corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "Lessee").

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee entered into an agreement on August 20, 2014, and

WHEREAS, Lessee has requested the addition of the following five City-owned parcels to the agreement:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein, and in full compliance with the terms of the agreements, Lessor and Lessee agree that all other provisions of the agreement will remain as first written.

#### AGREEMENT

This Agreement ("Agreement") entered into this 20<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2014, by and among the City of Davenport (the "City"), an Iowa municipal corporation, whose address for the purpose of this Agreement is 224 W. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Davenport, Iowa 52801, Eastern Iowa Community Colleges, Advanced Technology Environmental Education Center ("EICC/ATEEC"), an Iowa educational institution/not-for-profit corporation, whose address for the purpose of this license is 306 West River Drive, Davenport, Iowa 52801, and the Nahant Marsh Education Center (the "Nahant Center"), an Iowa not-for-profit corporation, whose address for the purpose of this Agreement is 4220 Wapello Avenue, Davenport, Iowa.

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of a 114 acre parcel of land, including a renovated building (the "Center") located at 4220 Wapello Avenue, Davenport, Iowa, commonly known as the Nahant Marsh (the "Marsh");

WHEREAS, the Nahant Center and the EICC/ATEEC or some other contracted organization are willing to assist with the operation of the Center and will provide their best efforts to support the Center;

WHEREAS, the Nahant Center and EICC/ATEEC have led and will lead fundraising efforts for operations at the Marsh;

WHEREAS, the Nahant Center is in the process of raising funds to build a \$220,000 addition to the Center;

WHEREAS, Nahant Center owns 151 additional acres which surround or abut the property owned by the City;

WHEREAS, the City has contributed \$7,500 cash annually (funded from the storm water utility fee);

WHEREAS, the above organizations all desire that the educational programs of the Center be successful.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned agree as follows:

1. TERM. The term of this Agreement shall be for twenty (20) years beginning on the date of execution of this Agreement with automatic five (5) year renewal terms until termination by ten (10) days written notice before the end of the initial term or any extension thereof.

#### 2. CENTER IMPROVEMENTS.

a. Routine Maintenance. The existing Center has previously been remodeled or renovated by the City, including all mechanical systems and the City has agreed to make all repairs including wear and tear and routine maintenance. The City is agreeable to the addition to the Center and will further agree to cover all repairs including wear and tear and routine maintenance in reference to said addition.

- b. Capital Expenditures. The Center will request future capital improvements and the City will review same and when approved, place them in capital improvement budgets.
- 3. MAINTENANCE COSTS. The City will continue to pay all utility charges and will provide all snow removal and mowing services at the Marsh.
- 4. INSURANCE. The City agrees to provide property, casualty and liability insurance on the Marsh and Center. The City will agree to provide general liability insurance on the Marsh and the Center in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 coverage.
- 5. NAHANT MARSH FACILITATOR/ECO EDUCATOR. EICC/ATEEC has interviewed and hired a Nahant Marsh Facilitator/ECO Educator and agrees that it will not subcontract the duties of the Facilitator without prior approval of the Board.
- 6. CENTER ACTIVITIES. The Facilitator and EICC/ATEEC shall be solely responsible for coordinating and scheduling organized groups and activities at the Center, including but not limited to: educational school groups, environmental organizations, research projects, workshops and seminars.
- 7. ACCESS TO CENTER. The City and EICC/ATEEC reserve unto themselves and their designees the right to free access and use of the Marsh and the Center and its facilities, subject to scheduling through EICC/ATEEC and confirmation that said activity and/or program will not conflict with an existing Nahant activity and/or program.
- 8. ECOSYSTEM MANAGEMENT. Decisions relating to overall management of the Marsh ecosystem will remain with the Nahant Board. Examples of ecosystem management decisions include but are not limited to decisions concerning location and design of viewing platforms, water control structures, walking paths, water level control, invasive species management, prairie management, prairie restoration and types and locations of plantings.
- 9. FUNDRAISING. The primary partner for fundraising efforts during the period of this Agreement shall be the EICC/ATEEC and Nahant Board. EICC/ATEEC, as an educational programmer, may be in a position to request additional funds for Center operations through grants, gifts or other means, and Nahant Board agree to cooperate and facilitate such fundraising endeavors as they may arise, under the direction of the Nahant Board. The City agrees to continue to contribute a minimum of \$7,500 per year the first 5 years; a minimum of \$8,500 per year during the next 5 years; a minimum of \$9,500 per year during the next 5 years, whether funded from storm water utility fees or other sources during the term of the agreement.
- 10. ANNUAL REPORT. Nahant will provide an annual report after the end of each calendar year.
- 11. NOTICES AND DEMANDS. All notices shall be given to the parties hereto at the addresses designated unless either party notifies the other, in writing, of a different address. Without prejudice to any other method of notifying a party in writing or making a demand to other communication, such notice shall be considered given under the terms of this license when it is deposited in the U.S. Mail, registered or certified, properly addressed, return receipt requested, and postage prepaid.

- 12. PROVISIONS BINDING. Each and every covenant and agreement herin contained shall extend to and be binding upon the respective successors, heirs, administrators, executors and assigns of the parties hereto.
- 13. ASSIGNMENT. Neither party shall assign this Agreement, in whole or part without the prior written consent of the other parties, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 14. GOVERNING LAW. This Agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Iowa. if any part or provision of this license shall be deemed to be invalid or illegal, then such invalid or illegal portion shall, so far as possible, not affect the validity or legality of the remainder of this license.
