Park and Recreation Advisory Board April 21, 2022 Staff Report

Riverfront Improvement Commission up-date: Chris Meyer

Notable updates from Staff

Park Operations

- Mowing districts were re-vamped due to staff shortages. The large area mowers are split in 3 districts, while trim mowers are split in 4 districts. Staff have consolidated starting locations down to the 29th Street shop and Marquette street shop. This change will allow for easier communication and cooperation between districts.
- Iowa American Water Company has taken over installation of their water meters this year.
- The seasonal employee who worked on these for the past 9 years did not return this year, so new staff have taken on this challenge and are doing great. The goal each year is to have restroom water turned on by April 15.
- Staff are hoping to have the full-time Horticulture and Environmental Educator on staff soon. This was previously a part-time position but was modified to a full time position and will be part of the Horticulture team while also creating environmental education programs.

Recreation

- CAPRA Accreditation has been submitted and is being studied by the assigned review team.
- Davenport Junior Theatre Spring Break Camp was full with 48 kids, a great time was had by all.
- Davenport Junior Theatre hosted the spring showcases on April 5 & 6: 250 students in 37 classes with 6 performances.
- Staff have been visiting high schools each week promoting summer and seasonal open positions which has resulted in approximately 70 applications submitted.
- 38 athletes move onto the State Special Olympics for Track!
- The St Patrick's Special Populations Dance had 100 attendees; it was the first event in two years for almost all of the attendees.
- Staff were able to accommodate all of the 60+ participant on the Spring Soccer waiting list onto teams.
- The adult soccer and softball leagues are filling up.

Revenue Facilities

• Slow start to the Golf Season concerning weather. All courses open as of April 10.

- Golf Courses and the department have a renewed exclusive beverage agreement with Pepsi Family products for the next 3 years.
 - DPR has been with Pepsi products since 2009.
- Duck Creek Golf and Red Hawk Golf getting 25 new trees each as part of Davenport's Arbor Day planting.

Top Staff Challenges

Park Operations

- Staffing needs update: need 4 Park Ambassadors, 2 mowers, 2 custodians, 2 Fejervary Learning Center hosts, 1 Horticulture staff, 1 Youth Corps lead, 1 Facility Attendant, and 3 maintenance. Recruitment efforts are still ongoing.
- Staff continue to struggle with getting the Tyler Park playground vendor to respond to inquiries. The Purchasing Manager has been notified, and staff may soon involve the Legal department to discuss options.

Recreation

- Even with the increased recruitment efforts, staffing is only slightly better than this time last year.
 - With regards to aquatic complex staffing: Staffing levels are not where they need to be to operate both complexes 7 days per week. However, a hybrid schedule could potentially be an option (similar to last year), if every current applicant interviews, passes background checks, accepts the position, and passes the trainings.
- The Pool Maintenance position is still vacant. This could potentially result in some issues down the line. There are staff who are CPO certified that can potentially aid in pool operations if one is not found in time.
 - The 1 applicant has been contacted but not interviewed as of the writing of this update.
- The soccer complex goals purchased to replace those destroyed in the March storm are delayed and will not arrive until early June. Staff are working on temporary solutions.
- Riley Vaughan, the AmeriCorps Program Manager, resigned April 15. Staff are evaluating the administrative structure for this position to see what options are available.

Revenue Facilities

 Staffing of mower operators is low. The position is ideal for 18+ (college age). However, due to increased job prospects for that age range, applications have been much fewer.
 Some high school aged applicants have contacted, but do not have the desired availability or experience for golf maintenance positions.
