The Davenport Civil Rights Commission (DCRC) met at 12:00 p.m. Tuesday, April 12, 2022, online using Zoom. Commission Chair Michael Guster, presided.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boyd to approve the agenda, it was seconded by Commissioner Transou. All commissioners voted yes.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

On motion by Commissioner Boyd, 2nd by Commissioner Lopez, the minutes of the regular meeting of the February 8, 2022 meeting were approved. All Commissioners voted yes.

REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR

Director Lacey stated there was no right to sue letters issued for the month of March, and there were no cases settled in mediation in the month of March.

Director Lacey stated she attended a HUD FHEO meeting. The Director also stated she continues to monitor COVID-19 rates and its impact on office functions. Director Lacey stated our area still has low vaccination rates. The Director stated the Annual Report is still being worked on. Director Lacey stated a Housing Analyst attended a Fair Housing Training Conference. The Director mentioned that April is Fair Housing Month. Director Lacey announced that on Tuesday, April 19, 2022, there will be a panel discussion at the Main Street Library, in downtown Davenport, at 6 p.m. The Director stated she is still waiting to hear from an EEOC trainer for Commission training. Director Lacey stated there is new guidance from DOJ on Opioid Use Disorder/Substance Use Disorder.

NEW BUSINESS

Commissioner Guster stated he alerted the Mayor of wanting a meeting to make things better between the City and the Commission. Commissioner Guster also stated he wanted a discussion about the Commission going back to in person public meetings and staff input about reopening the office and would like it added to the agenda.

Just Economy Training was discussed, the NCRC, in Washington D.C. Commissioner Boyd stressed other Commissioners getting training on regional and national training. Commissioner Boyd mentioned the new financial forms that need to be turned in to Beth Badillo. Each Commissioner was then asked where they were on getting those forms filled out. Most Commissioners had already filled out the form or were about done. Commissioner Pokora asked for a paper form to be sent to him to fill out. Commissioner Guster asked that a paper form be sent to Commissioner Pokora.

Commissioner Boyd stated that the Civil Rights Commission would be getting a proclamation at the upcoming City Council Meeting, and that she would be receiving it for the Commission. That meeting would be Wednesday, April 13, at 5:30 p.m.

Commissioner Transou stated there was a Pride in Memory event coming up on April 21st at 7 p.m. at Mary's on 2nd to celebrate LGBTQ history. The event would be an opportunity for folks to bring memorabilia to show or share with the Putnam Museum in Davenport for their collection on the community. The group is new and was formed to make sure the LGBTQ community remembers and documents their local history in the region.
