1. Minutes from July 19, 2023 Meeting

2. Planning JUSCC Meeting

- Bettendorf will plan to schedule the meeting for the second week in December.
- Set future meetings at the JUSCC meeting
- Support resolution for Flood Plan. Prepare the resolution for signature.

3. Flood Plan Update

- Clay Merritt reported that a Phase 1, SHIPO had questions about Architectural. We expect a report by Nov 4, 2023 and SHIPO to move forward. EDA will release to the Corp and they can start up the permitting process again. Hope to bid in February.
- Phase II, Brick Grant was rejected. Other funding options are being reviewed.
- Phase III, CP Bridge over tracks at Concord. RFQ for Engineering due on the 23 of October.
- Flood Plan related; V&K was asked to add a redundant Potable Water Main loop to feed the WPC Facility. Build the new main loop next year.

4. WPC Plant Projects

- Flow Channel Leaks –V&K provided an Engineering Design proposal for \$37,860 and Construction for \$16,440.
- RAS Flow Meters V&K provided a proposal for design and bid for \$6,754.
- Tri City has been rerouting power and controls for the digester feed valves from the Admin Building, SCADA. Clay to get the sidewalk project bid next spring.
- Staff completed the Digester #3 cleanout into a Geo Tube. Material is planned to be added back into the compost material this fall. They have also cleaned all the struvite from the 3 draft tubes and removed the material to the dewatering pad. Maintenance is gathering remaining parts for the mixer rebuilds.
- #2 Primary Clarifier.
 - i. Nestle discharged 70 ton of beef tallow.
 - ii. Nestle paid EMS to clean the tallow from the primary clarifier.
 - iii. Observed a hole at the bottom of the influent drive support column when the tank was cleaned.
 - iv. HR Green proposed a structural engineer inspect and a testing company test the steel thickness of the drive support column. They would provide a technical memo summarizing the problem and recommend repair or replacement. \$7,500.

- v. A patch has been made to weld over the hole after the engineer's assessment.
- Aeration Header Leaks
 - i. Inspect and plan repairs
- Rebuild Top end Gen #1 will be completed by Friday or next Monday.
- Replace #2 Generator vapor phase unit. The unit is ordered and being built. We are expecting delivery late January 2024.
- 5. HR Green TM
 - Digester Mixing
 - Digester Cover Replacement
 - Digester Code Assessment
 - Digester Heating
