- Palmer PID Rezoning- Discussion on the Mosaic Palmer PID Disparate Impact Analysis Report and input on the report provided by Calvin Bradford and Jack Cann. Last month, documents were distributed to the Commission with the understanding that they would be reviewed at the February meeting and returned to the Planning and Zoning Commission and Council. The Palmer PID application was removed from the table without prior notice or input from the Commission and approved February 6, 2018.
 - Alderwoman Rawson indicated that the application was removed from the table without input because the draft analysis of the Mosaic report had been leaked, she stated that she could not disclose to whom it was leaked or how.
 - Also stated that this is already a diverse neighborhood that she believes would be aided through her urban revitalization initiative which would create overlay districts.
 - Interested in procedural changes to the notification process, including sending notifications to occupants and owners.

DIRECTOR REPORT FOR THE DAVENPORT CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION FOR February 2018

I. CASE STATUS

- 1. No "right to sue" letters were issued in February.
- 2. During the month of February four employment cases settled in mediation and one settled in conciliation. One transit case settled in mediation.
 - i. The conciliated employment case, filed on the bases of sex, race, retaliation and disability, involved allegations of sexual and racial harassment where the Complainant was placed on leave and subsequently terminated after complaining about sex, race and disability discrimination.
 - ii. The four employment cases settled for \$75,000.00; \$20,000.00; \$2,300.00 and \$500.00 and relief in the public interest.
