Director's Report

Director Latrice Lacey gave an update on the meetings with Palmer School of Chiropractic; there will be a study done to assess the impact of the proposed PID. The main concern being that low-income housing would be torn down with no replacements set in place. University of Iowa Public Policy clinic has offered a partnership to work with the deaf community on developing policy initiatives for effective communication between first responders and the non-verbal community.

DIRECTOR REPORT FOR THE DAVENPORT CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION FOR September 2017

I. CASE STATUS

- 1. No "right to sue" letters were issued in September.
- 2. During the month of September, one housing case settled in mediation for relief in the public interest and housing. Two employment cases settled in mediation during the month of September. The first case, involving allegations of race discrimination, settled for \$2,500 and relief in the public interest; the second case also involving race discrimination allegations settled for \$2,250 and relief in the public interest.
